We continue to wish good health and wellness to all of our fellow Preserve members. Thank you to those of you who are assisting us in abiding by the county's "shelter-in-place" guidelines, practicing good social distancing, and making the most of this time with your families by enjoying walks and other safe recreational pursuits on our special property.

It has come to our attention, however, that there are occasional Preserve members continuing to play the golf course. While we may disagree with the rationale in the county's order specifically prohibiting golf and share everyone's desire to return to the fairways as soon and as safely as possible, we are obligated to abide by the county requirements, and we ask and expect all of our fellow members to join us in compliance.

The management staff are put in a difficult position when asked to confront members electing to play golf despite the current restrictions. As a result, they have been instructed to take note of any players they may encounter and remind them of the current closure. A second violation will result in a \$1,000 fine to the primary member and billed to your Preserve account. Any subsequent violations may be referred to the Joint Membership Committee for further consideration.

This is a challenging time for everyone, particularly those faced with the real health issues posed by COVID-19 and their families and those called to fight this pandemic on the front lines. We are fortunate in our position to be able to safely enjoy The Preserve while we shelter in place - even if it means forfeiting some of our recreational comforts in the meantime - and we are all looking forward to returning to the game we love soon.
